

TRIENNIUM PIN

(To be sold by all members – profit going to their charities)



THIS IS THE ONE PIN WHICH WILL BE SOLD THIS TRIENNUM.

YOU WILL BUY THE PINS FOR \$2.00 EACH TO TAKE CARE OF THE COST OF PINS. THE ADVANCE FOR THE PURCHASE OF THESE PINS CAME FROM GENERAL GRAND CHAPTER AND MUST BE REPAID.

You sell the pin to members or nonmembers for \$10.00. After you pay yourself for the \$2.00 you paid for them, you will realize an \$8.00 profit per pin, which you will give to the charity of your choice.

When you turn in the money you made to your charity or chapter, be sure to have some sort of receipt to send to your chapter so it may be reported in the annual report to General Grand Chapter. Make a notation that the funds came from the sale of the General Grand Chapter pin.

Anyone can buy the pins and use them for your chapter's charity. Check with your Worthy Matron to let her know that you will be supporting her charity through the sale of the pins. She, in turn, will have it annotated on the annual report the secretary sends to the Grand chapter.

- **10 pins cost \$20.00. Profit after you pay yourself for the initial cost: \$80.00.**
- **25 pins cost \$50.00. Profit after you pay yourself for the initial cost: \$200.00.**
- **50 pins cost \$100.00. Profit after you pay yourself for the initial cost: \$400.00**

And so on up the ladder according to your plan to raise a certain amount for some special project.

The pin is generic and though we Eastern Stars understand the significance of the colors, it is a pin anyone might like to wear because of its bright colors.
